 - One artistic or athletic
 - One of the letters may be from an educator or mentor outside of DWS
- Completed DWS Blue Scholarship application
- Families must be current with tuition
- Commitment to Waldorf education as evidenced by past DWS enrollment
- Strong commitment to DWS through volunteerism and participation in fundraising, events and activities
- Good academic standing
- Strong attendance record

Recipients are expected to demonstrate the following in the 2018–19 school year:

- Attendance at the 8th Grade Continuation Ceremony Thursday, June 1, 2018
- Provide a written thank you note to the Blue & Gold Scholarship Committee
- Maintain a strong commitment to DWS through volunteerism and participation in fundraising, events and activities
- Maintain good academic standing
- Maintain strong attendance record

2. Completed scholarship application (attached, completed by the student) must be submitted to the Admissions Office by ***Tuesday, October 17, 2017***. Incomplete or late applications may not be eligible for funding.
