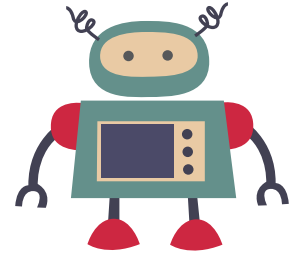
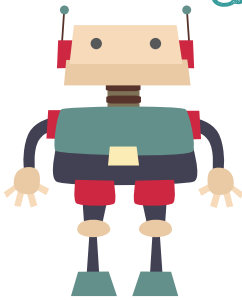


DWS 2017 SUMMER READING FOR RISING 2ND GRADE

4. Design a new cover for your favorite book.

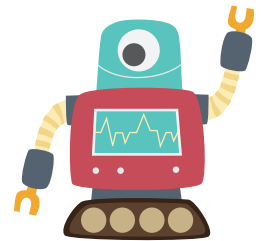
5. Write a review on the enclosed index cards.

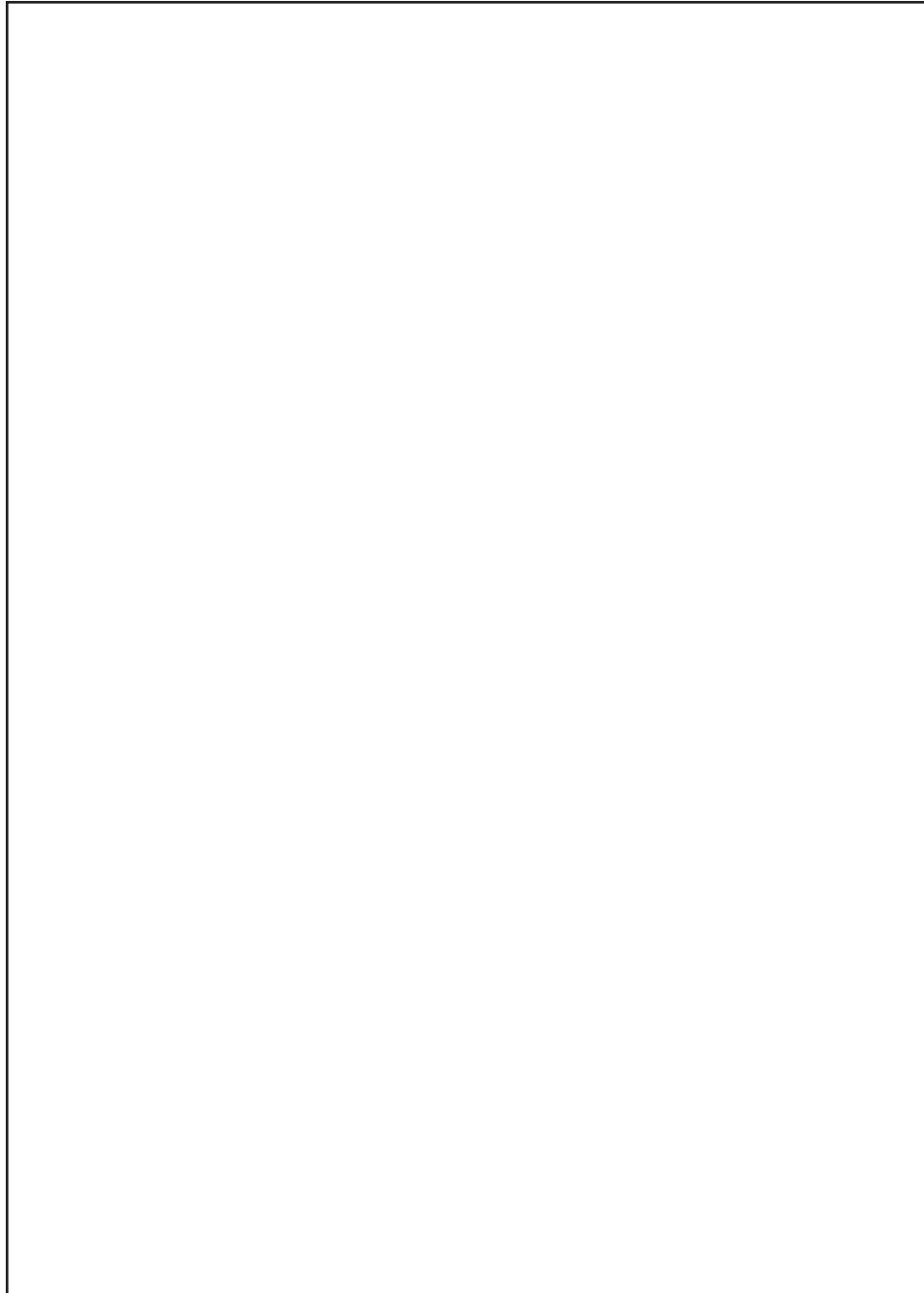
