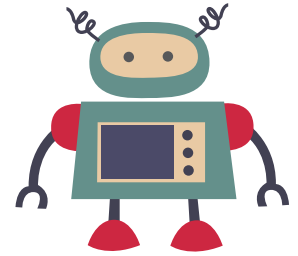
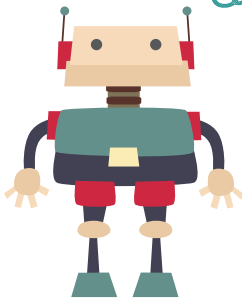


DWS 2017 SUMMER READING FOR RISING 3RD GRADE



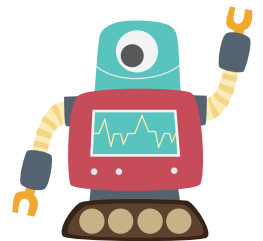

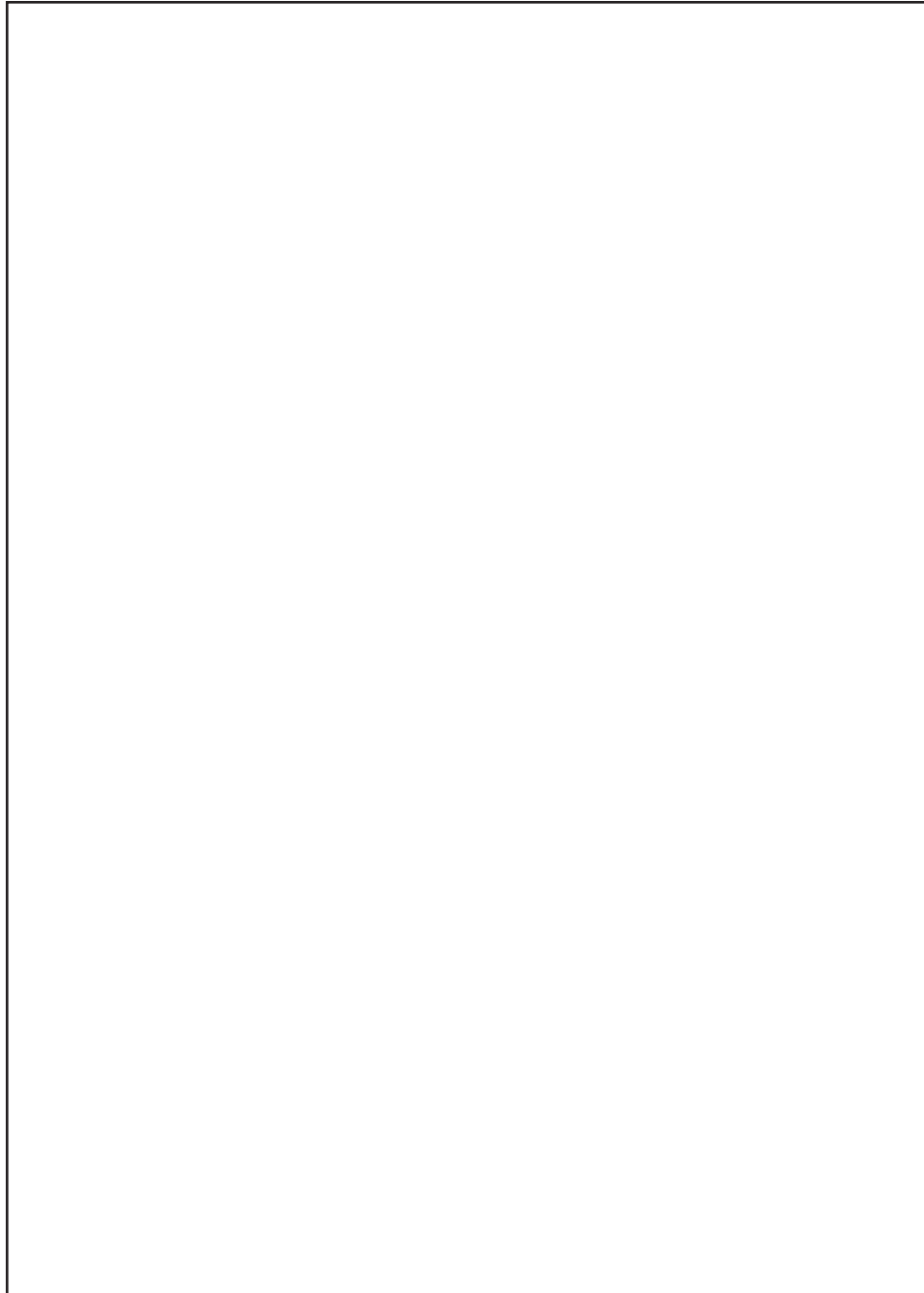
