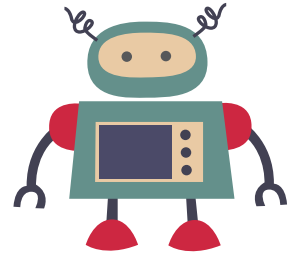


DWS 2017 SUMMER READING FOR RISING 8TH GRADE



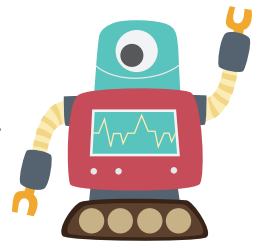

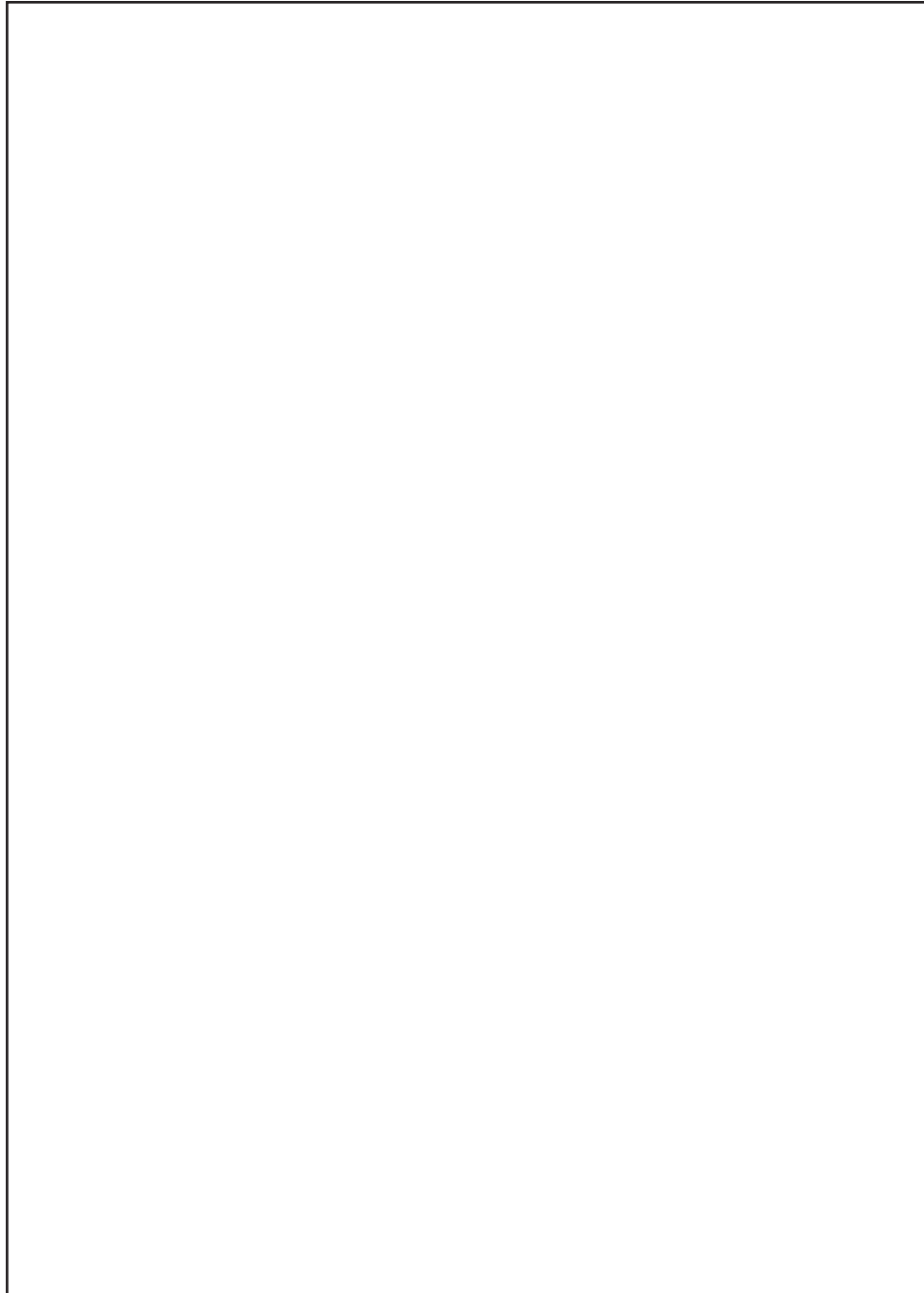
