The DWS Blue Scholarship recognizes dynamic, compassionate, striving students of The Denver Waldorf 8<sup>th</sup> Grade to attend the Denver Waldorf High School, who have displayed excellence in Academics, the Arts, and/or Athletics by offering financial support.

### **Qualifications:**

- Currently attending 8<sup>th</sup> grade at DWS
- Applying to the 9<sup>th</sup> Grade at DWHS
- Two Letters of Recommendation from the following:
  - One academic (main lesson, math, science, or world languages)
  - One artistic or athletic
  - One of the letters may be from an educator or mentor outside of DWS
- Completed the full DWS Blue Scholarship application by the deadline
- Families must be current with tuition
- Commitment to Waldorf education as evidenced by past DWS enrollment for one full academic year
- Strong commitment to DWS through volunteerism and participation in fundraising events and activities
- Good academic standing –completion of all assignments in a timely manner, a positive attitude towards work, demonstration of strong work ethic, best work completed
- Strong attendance record (no more than 3 tardies or 7 absences)

#### Recipients are expected to demonstrate the following in the 2019-20 school year:

- Attendance at the 8th Grade Continuation Ceremony Thursday, May 30, 2019
- Provide a written thank you note to the Blue & Gold Scholarship Committee
- Maintain a strong commitment to DWS through volunteerism and participation in fundraising events and activities
- Maintain good academic standing g.p.a of 3.6 or higher by end of freshman year
- Maintain strong attendance record (no more than 3 tardies or 7 absences)

### How to Apply:

- Submit Letter of Recommendation Requests (attached) to faculty members by *Friday*, *October* 5, 2018
- 2. Complete scholarship application (attached) completed by the student must be submitted to the Admissions Office by *Monday, October 15, 2018*.
- 3. Incomplete or late applications will not be eligible for funding
- 4. Application finalists may be invited to meet with the Blue & Gold Scholarship Committee.
- 5. All applicants will be notified of their application status via mail or email with school contracts.

- 2. Describe how Waldorf education has impacted you and your family.
- 3. Describe your favorite events or classes.
- 4. How will this scholarship affect you or have impact on your life?
- 5. What are your educational goals as they relate to academics, the arts and/or athletics?
- 6. Tell us about the greatest challenge in your life that you have overcome.
- 7. Describe your proudest moment or accomplishment from the last school year.
- 8. What was your favorite memory or interaction with your 8th grade teacher?
