



Ilse Nathan Foundation Scholarship Application for Current Recipients

The Ilse Nathan Foundation supports diversity in schools for children between the ages of 2 and 10. Each academic year, the scholarship is awarded to students of diversity with financial need. The scholarship is open to all students between the ages of 2 and 10 applying to or attending DWS. ***Applications for the 2019–2020 school year are due by Friday, February 1, 2019.***

Qualifications:

- Student belongs to a racial, ethnic or cultural group that has been historically underrepresented at The Denver Waldorf School
- Student must have completed the full enrollment process and have no outstanding tuition due
- Family demonstrates financial need as determined by TADS
- Commitment to Waldorf education as evidenced by past enrollment or, for new families, a pre-enrollment interview

When reapplying, recipients are expected to demonstrate the following:

- A strong commitment to The Denver Waldorf School through volunteerism and participation in fundraising, events and activities
- A written thank you note, a sample of school work and a brief description on how Waldorf education has impacted the student
- Good academic standing
- Strong attendance record

How to Apply:

1. Apply and be accepted at The Denver Waldorf School
2. Complete online application with TADS Financial Aid Assessment: *mytads.com*
3. Submit scholarship application (reverse of this form) to Brooke Camfield, Registrar, via email (registrar@denverwaldorf.org) or mail (2100 S Pennsylvania St, Denver, CO 80210)
4. Application finalists will be invited to meet with The Denver Waldorf School Diversity and Inclusivity Committee. All applicants will be notified of their application status via mail or email.
