



## **Joan Condon Scholarship Application for Current Recipients**

In an effort to support all of our families financially, The Denver Waldorf School provides needs-based scholarships to qualified students and their families. The scholarships are open to all students applying to or attending DWS. The number of scholarships and the amount granted will be determined based on applicant need and available funds each academic year.

***Applications for the 2019–2020 school year are due by **Friday, February 1, 2019.*****

### **Qualifications:**

- student must have completed the full enrollment process and have no outstanding tuition due
- family demonstrates financial need as determined by TADS
- commitment to Waldorf education as evidenced by past enrollment or, for new families, a pre-enrollment interview

### **How to Apply:**

1. Apply and be accepted at The Denver Waldorf School
2. Complete online application with TADS Financial Aid Assessment: *mytads.com*
3. Submit scholarship application (reverse of this form) to Brooke Camfield, Registrar via email ([registrar@denverwaldorf.org](mailto:registrar@denverwaldorf.org)) or mail (2100 S Pennsylvania St, Denver, CO 80210)
4. First time application finalists will be invited to meet with The Denver Waldorf School Tuition Adjustment Committee. All applicants will be notified of their application status via mail or email.

### **Recipients are expected to do the following:**

- demonstrate a strong commitment to The Denver Waldorf School through volunteerism and participation in fundraising, events and activities
- submit a written thank you note, a sample of school work and a brief description on how Waldorf education has impacted the student (These maybe submitted to the Registrar, Brooke Camfield.)
- maintain good academic standing
- maintain a strong attendance record
