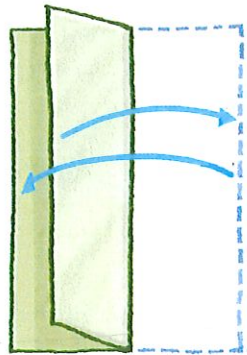


Paper aeroplanes

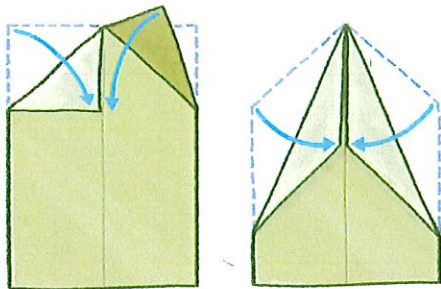
FLY away!

You will need:

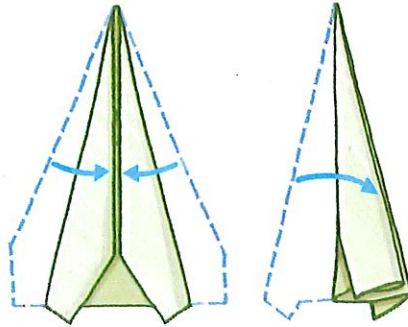
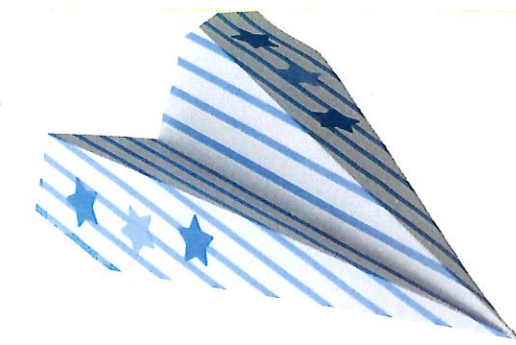
- Patterned paper, A4 (or US letter)
- Scraps of coloured paper for detail
e.g. star shapes, glue



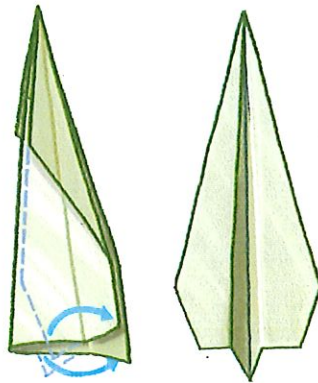
1. Place the paper in front of you, patterned side down. Fold in half lengthways and unfold again.



2. Fold both top corners down to meet the centre line. Then fold the new outer edges inwards in the same way.



3. Now fold the far outer edges inwards just as in step 2. Turn the plane over and valley fold it in half along your first crease.



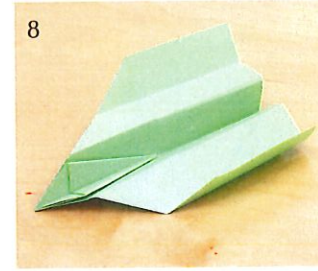
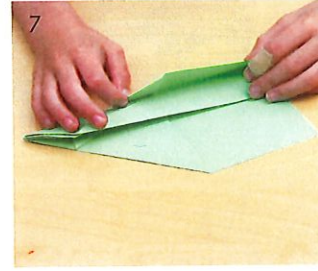
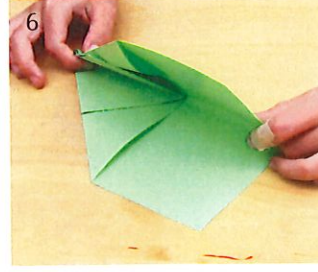
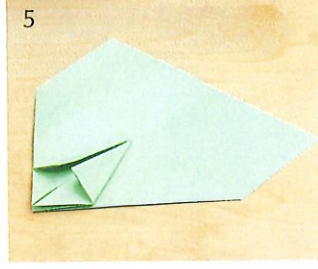
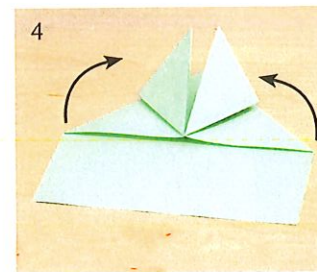
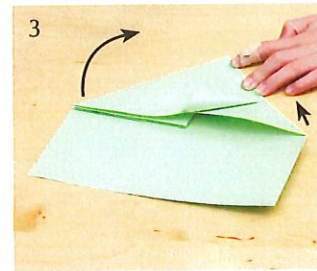
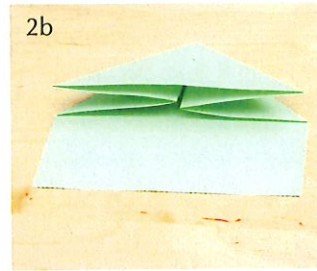
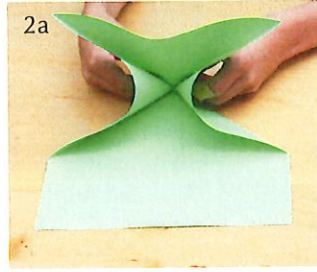
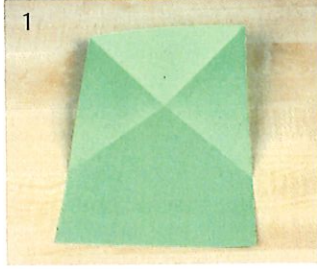
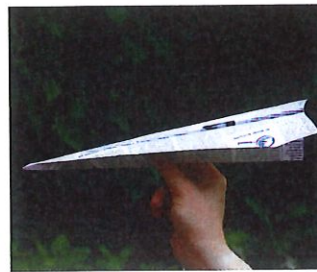
4. Crease all the folded edges firmly and then unfold the edges of the wings.

5. To finish, decorate your aeroplane with stars or other designs, and see how far it will fly!

Aeroplane 1

✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂
✂ paper

- 1 Fold an A4 (Letter) sheet down the middle lengthwise.
- 2 Fold one of the corners toward the closed side. Repeat this with the other side.
- 3 Repeat step 2 on both sides.
- 4 Repeat step 2 once again.



Aeroplane 2

✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂ ✂
✂ paper

- 1 Take an A4 (Letter) sheet and fold one of the corners to the opposite side. Do the same with the other corner.
- 2 Push both sides inward.
- 3 Fold a triangle at the top of the paper.
- 4 Fold both corners upward.
- 5 Repeat the fold as in 4.
- 6 Fold the aeroplane double lengthwise.
- 7 Make a fold on either side in the other direction.
- 8 Repeat 7.
