

Potato Heads

Making a potato head is an age-old activity that still adds up to great fun for kids.

Take a large baking potato and clean it up with a scrub brush. Now supply your child with clay or Play-Doh to make a nose, a mouth and ears. Pieces of felt can also be used to make eyes, a mouth, a mustache or beard. Use short lengths of toothpicks (cut them for your child and supervise their use) to affix the clay, paper, and felt to the potato. An old plastic scrub pad makes for a good shock of hair. If you purchase several potatoes, you and your child

can make a whole potato head family. potato heads might enjoy a ribbon or bow.

Required:

- Baking potatoes
- Clay or Play-Doh
- Colored paper
- Felt
- Toothpicks
- Ribbons or bows
- Scrub brush
